

New Planning Application to be Submitted for The Royal Hotel

Updated plans for the renovation of Llangollen's iconic Royal Hotel have entered the final stages of design.

The hotel, once considered one of the most prestigious hotels in Wales, has long been identified as requiring significant investment to re-establish itself in the tourist town.

An ambitious proposal for a major redevelopment was submitted and approved in early 2022. In the wake of the Covid-19 pandemic and subsequent economic instability in the hospitality industry, the programme has had to be re-evaluated and the timeline changed. In order to protect the longevity of the landmark hotel in the new climate, the design team have revisited the project and come up with a new scheme.

Despite the challenges and delays since the pandemic, there is still excitement about the development of hospitality venues in the area and confidence that The Royal can return to a position of prominence in the region.

Now in the final stages of design, planning for the new scheme is expected to be submitted to Denbighshire County Council in the coming months.
